Your meter readings and bills

We will read your meter **three times a year** and then send you the corresponding bill. If you are not at home when we visit, and we are unable to read the meter, we will send a bill based on estimated consumption.

Your meter must be read by one of our authorised representatives at least once a year. If you are absent at the time of their visit you must contact us with the actual meter reading within 48 hours:

- By post: Simply return the completed "carte verte autorelève" (the green, meter reading card) that can be found in your letter box;
- By telephone: Just call one of our team on 0969 397 901 (calls charged at local rate);
- By Internet: Visit our website www.seolis.net and send us your meter reading under the heading "Saisissez vos index" (click here to enter meter readings).

Just what I need! Electricity plans at regulated tariffs. Tariffs with effect from 1st February 2025.

Choosing the right plan

There are three possible electricity plans, all at regulated tariffs:

Basic Plan, Off-Peak Plan or Tempo Plan. Just ask your SÉOLIS adviser to calculate the most appropriate one for you.

We recommend that you take out or retain your existing plan with national, regulated tariffs. These tariffs are set by the government and therefore remain stable.

Note: Please be aware that in order to benefit from the tariffs outlined in this leaflet, **electricity consumption must be for domestic use only** (in accordance with the ruling of 29/07/2021 relating to regulated tariffs of electricity sales).

Choosing the right power for your electricity supply

Electricity power supply is measured in kVA (kilo-volt-amps) and determines the capacity of your system to feed in the same time all the electrical appliances in your home.

To ascertain the power level you require simply add up the maximum power requirements of all your appliances that will be switched on at the same time.

Every power demand has a corresponding circuit breaker trip rating which is measured in amps.


